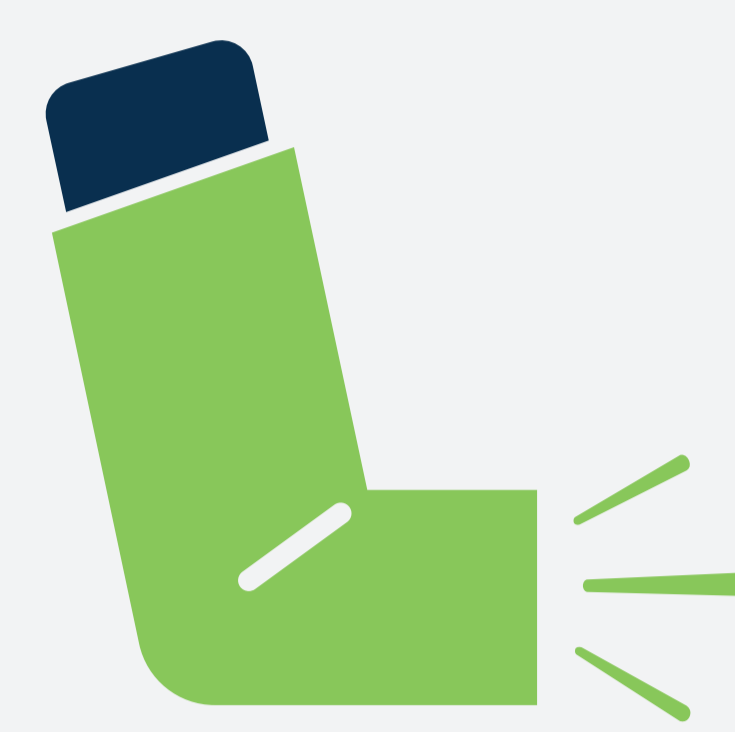


Daycare clean air is important for maintaining a healthier learning environment. See what dirty daycare air can do.

One sneeze can spray

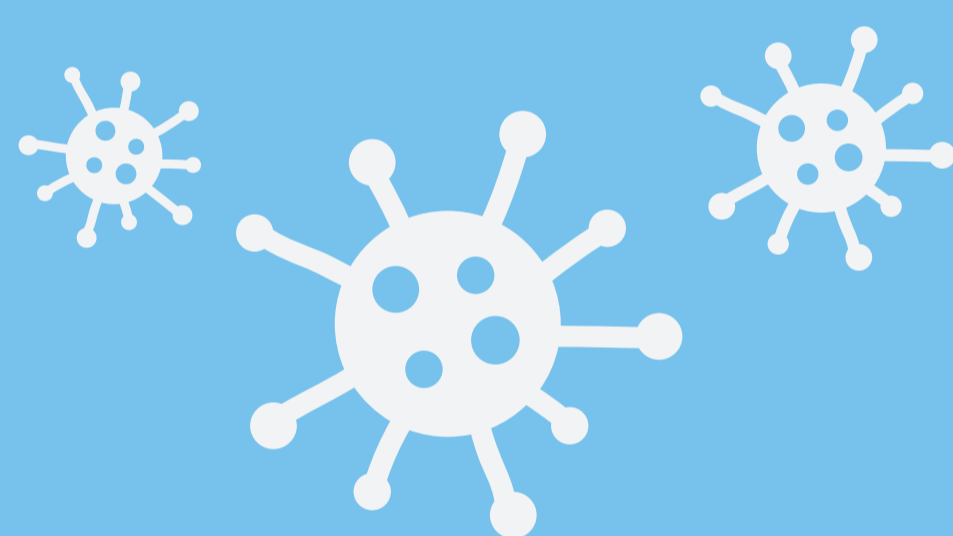
3,000 infectious droplets

6 to 10 diapers per day

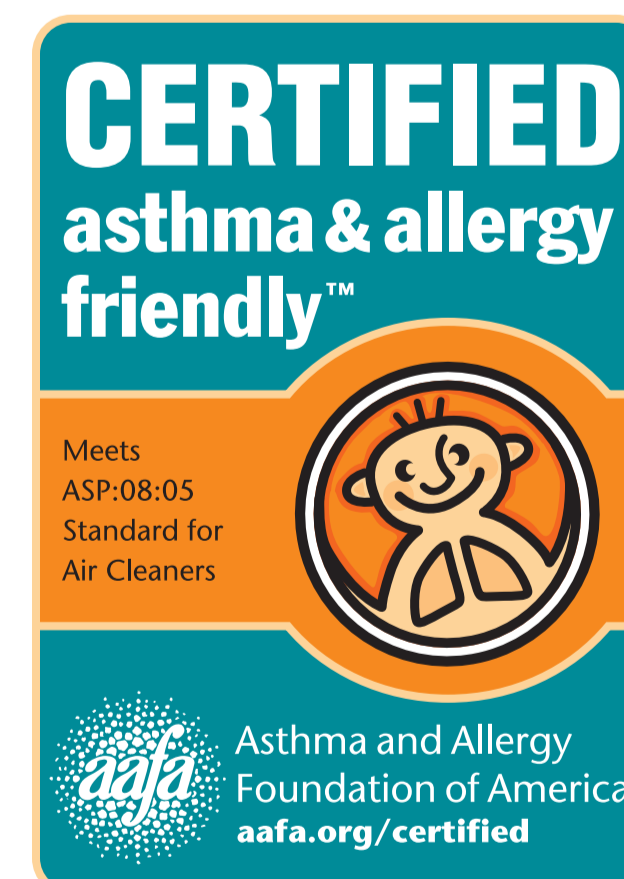
